SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Army Women's Foundation Scholarship and Legacy Scholarship Program provides grants to active, retired, Reserve, and National Guard Army women (past and present) and their lineal descendants (both male and female) to help them attain their educational goals. Scholarship recipients are selected based on merit, academic potential, community service, letters of recommendation, and financial need.

For the past 12 years, the program has impacted the future of over 250 recipients from 41 states and territories, valuing over \$490,000 - supporting not only those in 4-year college programs, but also certificate, community college, and graduate programs. This year, we have selected 19 Army women and 15 children of Army women to receive scholarships.
